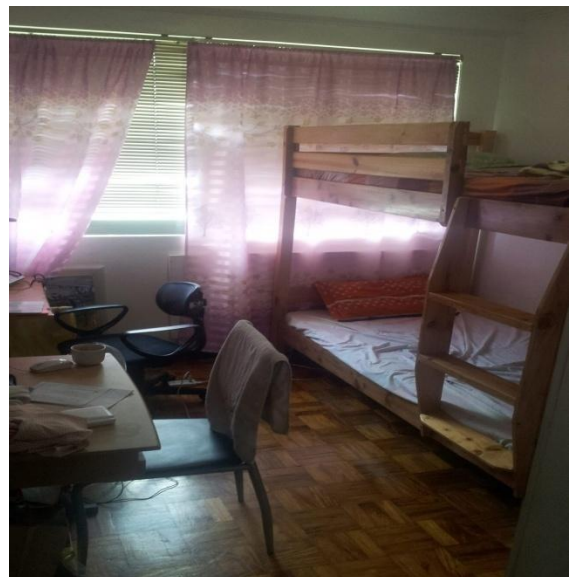

IN-HOUSE FACILITIES



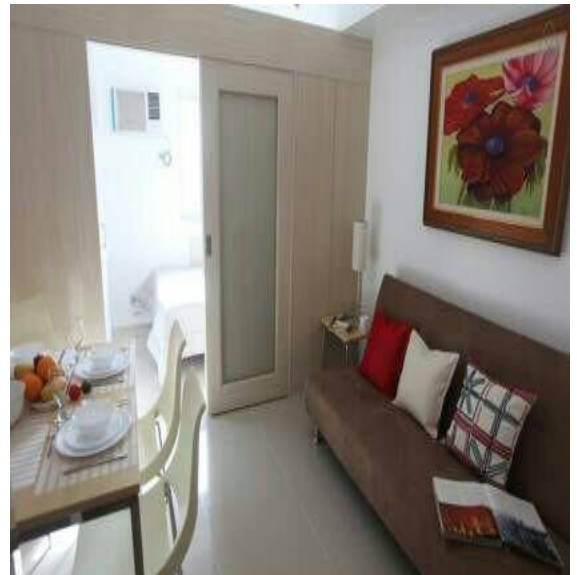
IN-HOUSE DORMITORY

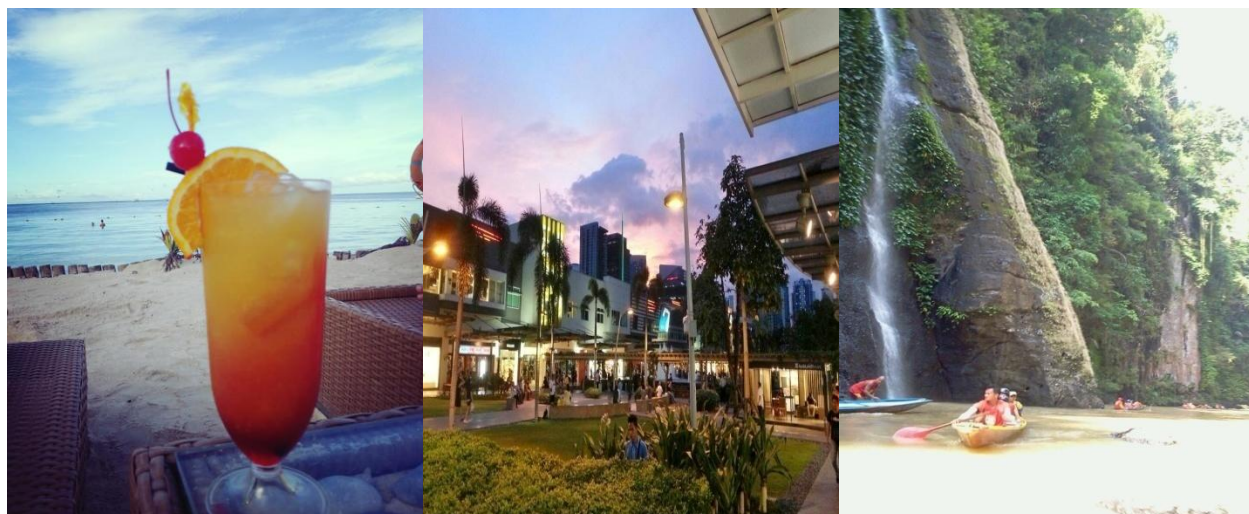
