## STUDENTS STAYING IN HOMESTAY

## ICC HAWAII ON THE MAP

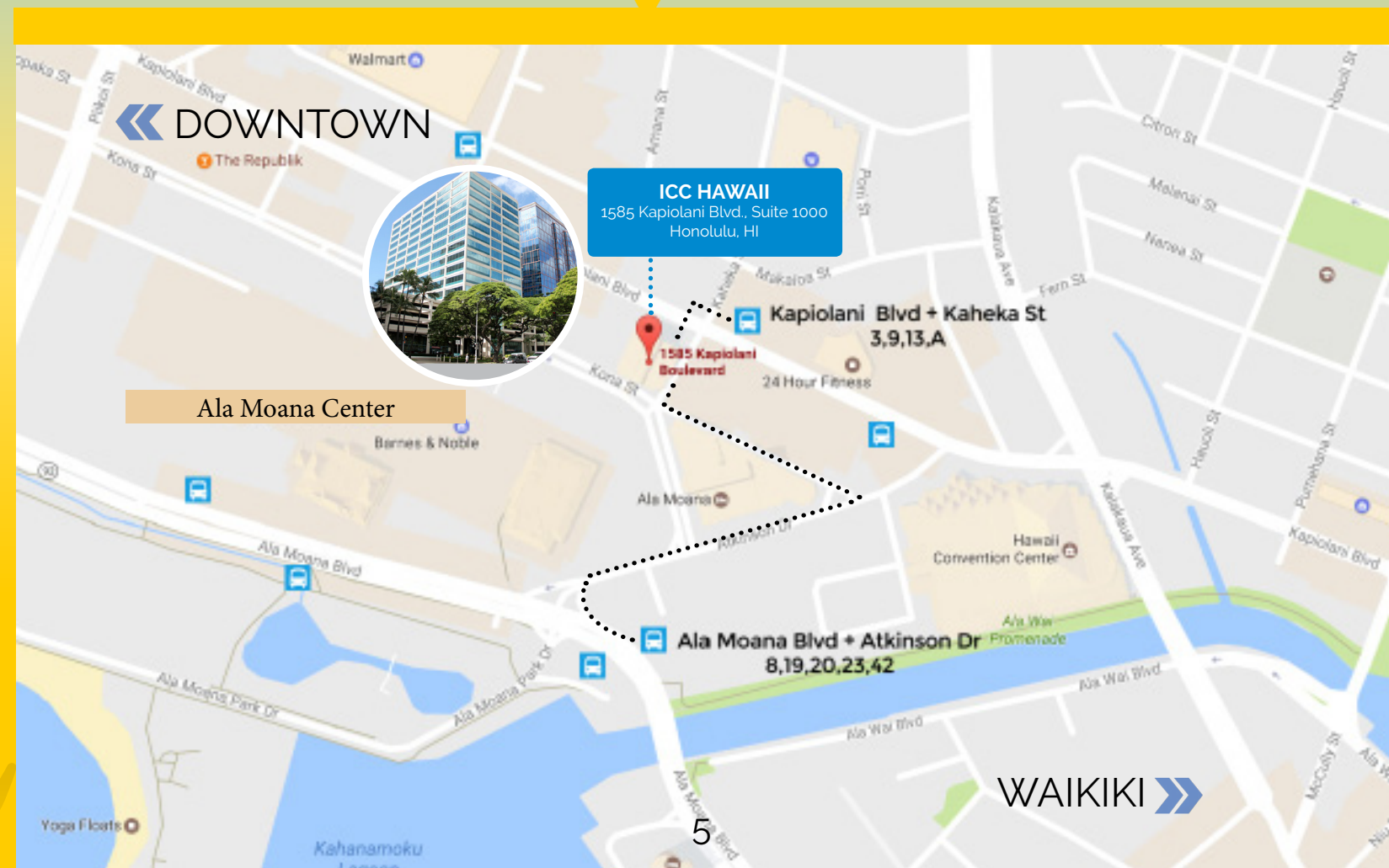
The following map below shows which buses stop near ICC Hawaii. During orientation day, students (Teens) will receive more information on How to Ride the bus.
